We are the only local service that is active seven days a week, operates on a delivery basis, and supplies baby necessities.

We aim to ensure all our work follows our core principles of empowerment, good faith, and collective decision-making, as well as consistent, respectful and reflective practice.

VISION

We believe that nobody should face food insecurity or experience stigma for seeking assistance.

Our Kitchen Collective programme has to date provided over 30,000 meals to the community, which, as well as providing nutritious meals to those with minimal cooking facilities.

This has been vital in bringing together organisations from across the city, including colleges, universities and local groups

WINTER CHALLENGE 2021

since OMA was founded 20 months ago, the demand has generally increased week on week, month on month. More recently however, a number of factors have combined to put considerable strain on our organisation

First, Brexit has caused considerable disruption to the UK's supply chains in almost every sector. Rising fuel prices and fuel shortages have increased our transport costs significantly, meaning we have had to cut spending in other areas.

The impact of food shortages has been even more serious. Most of the 5 tonnes of food that OMA distributes every week is food surplus, meaning we are at the end of the food chain. As a consequence, we frequently run out of food and other basic essentials.

Finally, as we enter the winter months, Covid cases have been spiking. Therefore, so too has the need for OMA's help.

If OMA did not exist, these people would not have anyone to turn for emergency food support and other basic necessities, nor would their social workers and / or link workers.

CHRISTMAS AT OMA

At OMA, while food and other essential supplies support are the bedrock of operations, we also believe that the many atrisk individuals and families should not have to face additional hardship during the holidays because of the financial strain it places on them, or because they are marginalised or excluded members of the community.

Showing solidarity is not just about working together hard to ensure that everyone has access to the things they need to simply subsist, but also about the spreading of joy, of making people feel equal and valued, and creating a sense of community.
